Vaishali	House Keeping	She went to school until 5th grade, at which time her parents refused to let her continue because they believed she was ready to marry. She was forced to marry when she was 12 years old. Her parents are very poor farmers, without access to clean water or enough food. Her 2 younger brothers were allowed to study because they are boys. Her husband had an unexpected heart attack while working in a field. So her 2 children now live with her parents while shes lives with her aunt so she can work at NBCH. She likes working here because it is beautiful and peaceful. She believes in Jesus but the rest of her family is Hindu.
Pratiksha	House Keeping	She went to school until 8th grade because her family was poor. She got married at age 16 and has 2 boys and 1 girl. Her husband is a driver. They have to buy water because it is too expensive to have water at home. She depends on NBCH because work is very hard to find. She likes working here because the boss is nice and the work is good. She believes in Jesus, but her husband and family are Hindus. Her children are asking questions about God and want to learn more.
Kavita	House Keeping	She went to school until 7th grade because there was too much work at home for her to do. Her parents were farmers, so they had just enough food to survive. Her family is Hindu. She was widowed after her husband committed suicide. She raises her 3 boys along, which is very difficult. She has to work hard so they can study. When she came to work at NBCH she heard about God. She has come to know more about God and now likes to worship and pray to God.
Suneeta	Cook	She was blessed to finish school. Her mother worked for a medicine company and her father was a farmer. So they had enough money for food and water. She got married at age 17. Her husband is a plumber. She has 1 daughter and 2 sons. It is hard to raise kids Because both her and her husband work a lot. She depends on her job at NBCH because she does not believe she would find work elsewhere. Her family is not Christian, rather they are a part of a Hindu-like religion.
Ranjana	Cook	She went to school until 3rd grade. She stopped going because she did not like it and nobody forced her to go. Her parents were farmers, so her family was very poor growing up, without enough money for food or water. She got married when she was 13. She has 1 boy and 2 girls. Her husband was a plumber, but after he had a heart attack he could not work. Her 2 girls are married. Her boy works sometimes. She is Hindu, but often hears about Jesus at NBCH.
Pushpa	Cook	She never went to school because she had to work. Her parents were very poor farmers. She got married at age 15. Her husband is a construction worker. Together they have 1 boy and 1 girl. They do not have enough money to provide enough food, clothing, and water for her children. She loves to cook so she is thankful for her job at NBCH. She and her family are Hindus.
Chandrakala	Cook	She went to school until she was 10, but she never returned after she was hurt by someone there. Her parents were very poor farmers so they did not have enough clothes, food, or water for her and her 5 sisters. She married at age 14. She has 3 girls and 1 boy. The girls are now married, but sadly her son ran away from home. Although she worked very hard she did not have enough money to send her kids to school. She loves to cook so she is glad she can work cooking here. She is a christian and she has been baptised. Her husband got ran over by a car and he went to church and was healed there. She is very grateful to God for an oppotunity to work here.
Usha	House Keeping	She went to school until 10th grade, but could not pass the final exams. Her mother died when she was young and her father later remarried. They were very poor when she was young. She has 2 sisters and 2 step brothers. She got married at 19 and now has 2 boys. Her husband is a driver. They do not have a lot of money, but enough to survive. She loves working with children here and everyone she works with is kind. She is Hindu, but is a good listener when coworkers and children tell her about Jesus.
Sangeeta	House Keeping	She quit school in the 5th grade because she did not want to study and no one made her go. Her father was a driver and her mother stayed at home with the children. She got married at 13 years old. She only has 1 son because they had trouble having children. It took 17 years for their only son. Her husband cleans. She likes to clean so she is thankful to work at NBCH. She and her family are Hindu.
Suman	Cook	She never went to school because her family was very poor. She had to help her parents on ther farm when she was young. When they worked they had food but when they did not work they did not have food. She got married when she was very young and now has 2 daughters and 2 sons. Her husband does not work. So she alone provides for the family. Her sons work and help the family some. Her older daughter is married with 2 boys and 2 girls. She likes everything about working here. She was baptized after hearing about Jesus at NBCH.
Pathan	Teacher	He has worked at NBCH for 6 years. He works with the 10th grade students to help them pass their final exams. He went to school and graduated with 3 college degrees. He is married with 1 daughter and 1 son. His wife is a teacher, with a college degree. He likes the staff here and that they work well together. It is a good environment to work in. He and his family are Muslims.
Raju	Teacher	He graduated from college with a degree in science and has training in education. His mother was a house wife and his father worked in the government. He could not afford college, so his class teacher paid his fees because the teacher believed in him. He now teachers at a government school. He is married with 2 children. He wanted to help orphan students, so he is happy he can help them get the education he worked so hard for. He and his family are Hindus.
Kanta	Nurse	She grew up in a Christian children's home from age 5 until her 10th year of school. Her father was a farmer. She went there to get a good education and have a better life. She was married at 22 years old. Her husband is a pastor. They have been married 40 years. She has 3 grown sons and 1 grown daughter. They all had good education because her job as a nurse was able to provide well for her family. She loves working and serving the children here. Her whole family is Christian.
